

BUCKAROO RODEO BIBLE CAMP

We want to support and insure a safe and secure camp for our campers and staff, as well as to provide a positive environment for everyone involved with BRBC. To achieve this goal, we ask that all campers adhere to the following rules and guidelines:

1. PLEASE NOTE: Campers who do not follow the camp rules and guidelines are subject to expulsion from camp and will forfeit all paid camp fees.
2. CELL PHONE use is not allowed during camp times unless approved by a staff member. Unauthorized use will result in confiscation of the device until the end of the camp day.
3. Camp prohibits all other personal electronic devices and are subject to confiscation. We will return the items to the Camper after the awards ceremony on the last day of camp.
4. Campers may NOT operate any motorized vehicles during camp. This includes personal vehicles.
5. The bucking machine is under the supervision of the Rough Stock Instructor and only used when he or another designated BRBC staff member is running the controls.
6. NO alcohol, drugs, or tobacco allowed at camp. This includes chewing tobacco and vaping products. Camp staff will administer prescription medications daily as needed.
7. Campers must turn over Prescription medications brought to camp during daily check-in so that we can secure the medications and administered them in accordance to label instructions.
8. We encourage Christ honoring relationships between boys and girls; NO public displays of affection (no laying or sitting on a member of the opposite sex).
9. Campers must not leave the BRBC camp facilities and grounds during camp time unless accompanied by a BRBC staff member. Camper must notify BRBC Staff members before leaving camp with a parent/guardian for any reason.
10. Parents/Guardians must check Campers under eighteen (18) years of age in and out of camp.
11. We expect Campers to be on time for all meals, meetings, and clinic times. We require campers to attend all scheduled activities. Campers may not be in a clinic area unless registered for that event.
12. Campers are to respect and obey the instructions of the counselors, instructors, and camp personnel. Instructors and the Camp Director have final say on all performance parameters for the rodeo.
13. Any Camper defacing camp property must pay for the damage incurred and face expulsion from camp.
14. Horses are not to be out of the corrals except during clinic and rodeo times. Campers must lead horses through the parking lot (no riding of horses). There will be no riding of horses on the first day (Sunday) of camp.

15. Non-horse owners may not be in the horse pens without an instructor present.
16. Humane treatment of animals is always expected . We require reporting of any case of injury or illness to Campers or animals at once.
17. Absolutely NO Campers or horses may be in the Round-Up Arena without an instructor present. Campers can only ride horses on the dirt track. The grass area is STRICTLY OFF LIMITS.
18. The horse used during camp clinics by the Camper is the horse that they must use during the rodeo. Campers may not switch horses for performance unless specifically approved by the instructor. No exceptions.

DRESS CODE

We expect that everyone will dress in a manner pleasing to God and in such a way, which does not draw unnecessary attention to self. To promote a positive environment at camp and for the safety of our campers, BRBC requires that all campers adhere to the following dress code guidelines while attending camp.

1. All clothing worn by campers should be modest and in good taste.
2. Shorts must be within three inches of the kneecap and only worn during free time.
3. NO Excessively tight or low-riding jeans allowed.
4. NOT ALLOWED - spaghetti strap tops, crop tops, see-through tops, muscle shirts, or cut-off shirts with low-cut arm pits. Campers may wear sleeveless shirts with a shoulder strap width of at least two inches that does not reveal the under garments.
5. Campers MUST always wear appropriate undergarments .
6. Campers MUST wear boots around livestock at all time. NO Flip Flops or Tennis Shoes allowed.
7. If a camper is in violation of the dress code, BRBC staff will ask the camper to change. If the camper refuses or continues to disregard the dress code, they will check-out with their parent/guardian at that time and then return the next day of camp with proper apparel.

By signing this form, we the undersigned, certify that we have read and understand the above rules and guidelines. We also acknowledge the fact that non-compliance with these rules and guidelines may result in the camper's expulsion from camp.
